

## **INTERNSHIP**

The Energy and Climate Intelligence Unit (ECIU) is offering an exciting opportunity for students or recent graduates with an interest in climate issues, to work with the team for 6-8 weeks this summer. This internship will be paid the [London Living Wage](#) and transport allowance.

### **What you will do**

- You will work on a specific project to support one of ECIU's programmes, bringing your analytical skills to bear on these important issues.

### **What you will learn**

- Experience how a small team in the sector works to achieve impact
- Pick up skills and knowledge for a future career in or around our sector.

### **Requirements**

We are looking for potential more than experience, offering this role as a learning and development opportunity to kick-start your future career.

You should have:

- An interest in climate and energy issues in the UK and/or beyond.
- An interest in and understanding of the UK political and economic context in which delivery of net zero sits.
- Enthusiasm for, and preferably some experience (whether in employment, personal or academic context) of complex analysis.
- Effective and straightforward communication skills.
- The willingness to work in a team, and independently, seeking guidance and support where needed, and working to deadlines.
- The ability to be innovative and creative, motivated and able to work across issues, and with people at any level.
- Some understanding of the UK media and social media space.

We value diversity and inclusion and are keen to make our sector more welcoming and accessible to a greater diversity of backgrounds. We welcome applicants from groups currently under-represented in our sector, including: people from a Black, Asian or other minority ethnic background; people from a socially or economically disadvantaged background; people who consider themselves to have a disability.

You must have the right to work in the UK.

**Location:** We envisage that the internship will take place at our offices near Borough station in central London. There will be support with transport costs.

**Hours/Duration:** This is a 6-8 week placement which will take place in the summer, likely starting in July, although timing is slightly flexible. Our office hours are 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday.

**Salary:** London Living Wage (£11.95/hour), plus travel expenses.
