NECCUS is an alliance of industry, government and experts, united by their determination to drive the changes and programmes needed to reduce carbon emissions from industrial sources in Scotland and beyond. We have over 50 industry members from local supply chain through to large international companies. This secondment would enable the secondee to engage with CCS and hydrogen projects and a wide-range of key industrial players and government.

Specifications of job role

Building out on energy transition/sustainability policy awareness the secondee will provide analysis and research on Scottish, UK and European policy focussed on industrial decarbonisation in Scotland, in particular policy associated with CCUS and hydrogen, to the members of NECCUS. They will deliver knowledge exchange through the NECCUS Knowledge Channel, newsletter, briefing papers, webinars and member meetings, and lead on consultation responses. NECCUS staff work online from home and there is no physical office so the candidate will need to work from home, but also be able to undertake travel to conferences and meetings. The role is likely to be full-time, but part-time working would also be acceptable.

Details of preferred secondee

The secondee needs to have postgraduate experience of policy, to MSc or PhD level, focussed on the energy transition or sustainability, and ideally with some knowledge of CCS and hydrogen sectors.

Intended secondment duration

To the end of February 2024.
